INFORMATION TO THE PUBLIC

R.O.C. No. 174/2025, Dated: 29.04.2025

1) As mandated under Rule 22, every complaint under the Tamil Nadu Lokayukta Act, 2018 shall be made in the Form prescribed in Schedule-V and shall contain the following particulars, namely:-

- (i) the name and address of the complainant;
- (ii) the name, official designation and address of the public functionary against whom the complaint involving grievances or allegations is made; and
- (iii) the details of the contents of the action complained of/and of the allegations.

2) As mandated under Regulation No.4 of the Tamil Nadu Lokayukta Regulations, 2022, every complaint shall be supported by an affidavit of the complainant. Further, the said affidavit shall contain the details of the allegations. The affidavits need not be typed in the Non-Judicial stamp papers. They can be typed in the plain white papers.

3) As per Rule 23 of the Tamil Nadu Lokayukta Rules, 2018, a complaint may be presented in person to the Registrar or any other officer duly authorised by him in this behalf or be sent by post.

The aforesaid procedure shall be followed strictly. As per the said provision, complaints cannot be sent by any other mode such as e-mail, whatsapp message, etc.,
